Hanoi Sees No Change In Relations With South

HANOI, North Vietnam, April 21 (Agence France-Presse) North Vietnamese officials believe that the resignation of President Nguyen Van Thieu of South Vietnam will not change things fundamentally, and that continued fighting seems inevitable, according to a high official source.

The source said today that the president had been replaced by his own Vice President, Tran Van Huong, and that the same generals remained in power. Negotiations with that administration can hardly be envisaged, the source said.

Radio Hanoi took the same line in its news bulletin today announcing the resignation of President Thieu.
