Danes Bar Projected Loan Of \$27-Million to Hanoi

COPENHAGEN, April 23 (Reuters)—A Danish parliamentary committee departed today from the country's traditional policy of aid-without-strings when it rejected a Government application to lend North Vietnam 150 million kroner—about \$27-million.

The majority of the finance committee did not consider that the time was right for such a loan because of the North Vietnamese role in the battle for control of South Vietnam.

The loan was intended to finance the building of cement factories with Danish equipment and technical assistance. Details had already been worked out by Hanoi and the Danish company, F. L. Smith, but the order will now probably go to Japanese concerns.
