# A Plea for Money To Aid Refugees

The San Francisco International Institute announced yesterday the beginning of an emergency fund to assist destitute refugees from South Vietnam.

Audrey Doughty, institute director, said that money will be solicited to handle emergency needs of refugees expected here from temporary sanctuaries in the Philippines, Guam and Wake Islands.

The fund will be administered by professional social workers, and an audited accounting of expenditures will be available later, she said
