Danang Schools Reported Open

HANOI, April 28—Tens of thousands of children went back to school in some 30 public and private schools in Danang, second city of South Vietnam, five days ago, the North Vietnamese News Agency reported here today.

The agency said that on April 23 "The entire city of Danang was sparkling white with the new clothes of

crowds of children going joyously to school."

The correspondent said classrooms were decorated "with portraits of President Ho Chi Minh and quotations from his instructions to Vietnamese children." In many schools "pupils began their studies with the teachings of Ho Chi Minh and learned revolutionary songs."
