Cambodia Said to Assure Sihanouk About His Return

PEKING, April 29 (Agence France-Presse) — Prince Norodom Sihanouk of Cambodia received assurances today from the new authorities in Phnom Penh that he would return to his country, informed sources said here.

The sources said that the assurances brought to an end a long period of uncertainty about the exact date of Prince Sihanouk's return.

The date of Prince Sihanouk's return is not yet known, but he is expected to stay in Peking at least until May 5, the date of the cremation of his mother, Queen Mother Kossamak, who died here on Sunday.
