Mrs. Ky Reaches U.S. as a Refugee

TRAVIS AIR FORCE BASE, Calif., April 29 (AP) — Mrs. Nguyen Cao Ky, wife of the former South Vietnamese Premier and Vice President, arrived in the United States last night as a refugee.

"She was treated the same as anybody else, no red carpet," said a Travis Air Force Base source after the government-chartered Trans International Airlines jet landed.

Mrs. Ky, among 211 passengers from Guam left the plane with several people who appeared to have been in her party. Her husband was not on the plane.

She was described as looking very tired as she left the base and apparently headed for San Francisco 45 miles away.
