Indonesia's Cease-Fire Unit Quits Saigon Temporarily

JAKARTA, Indonesia, April 29 (UPI)—Indonesia said today that she had ordered the temporary withdrawal from Saigon of her entire staff on the International Commission for Control and Supervision in Vietnam because of the deteriorating situation.

A Foreign Office statement said: "The Government considers the developments in and around Saigon to be such that safety of our personnel cannot be guaranteed. The withdrawal is temporary and does not imply a total pullout. When the situation permits, they still can be sent back."
