## MAY 1 1975 Viet Refugees Reported to Be In Good Health

Washington

A Department of Health, Education and Welfare's spokesman said yesterday, that the thousands of South Vietnamese refugees enroute to the United States are generally in good health and, as far as is known, carry no exotic diseases.

"These refugees pose no more of a problem to the health of Americans than the thousands of other travelers who enter this country from the Far East every year," said Dr. Theodored Cooper, HEW assistant sectoretary-designate for health coopers.

"No health conditions unknown to the United States; have been reported among the refugees so far," he, said.

Cooper said fewer than 901 of the nearly 34,000 refugees? received on Guam by yesterday morning had been hospitalized.
