

**Mrs. Ford Describes
Sadness on Vietnam**

Betty Ford said yesterday that she and President Ford were deeply saddened by the fall of the South Vietnamese Government and called the surrender by President Duong Van Minh "very tragic."

"Of course the President is very upset," Mrs. Ford told reporters on Fifth Avenue after attending a fashion show and luncheon sponsored by the American Cancer Society. "I'm sure everybody in the country is very upset about the conditions"

"It's been discussed in great detail, and I'm sure that he will express himself over the air to the whole country," she said of her conversation with the President on the subject.

"I feel as deeply saddened as he," added, "It's one of those very tragic things."
