

Thieu Reported Angry at U.S.

Taipei

Nguyen Van Thieu is not going to seek asylum in the United States because he is "very angry" with the U.S. government, sources close to the former South Vietnamese president reported yesterday.

One source said Thieu and his family are furious

because "the U.S. government did not honor its commitment to South Vietnam, resulting in the dire consequences leading to the fall of Saigon."

The sources said if Thieu decides to leave Taiwan, he would prefer to go to Europe.
