Sea Rescue

Of 3000

Refugees

Copenhagen

A Danish freighter picked up about 3000 refugees from a sinking ship off the South Vietnamese coast last night and headed for an undisclosed port, a shipping company spokesman said.

Carsten Borch, vice president of the A. P. Moeller Shipping Co., said the 14,000-ton Clara Maersk was somewhere between South Vietnam and Borneo.

He said the latest report from the skipper, Captain Anton Olson, indicated all aboard were well.

"They are now on deck, in all the crew cabins, and in the holds," he said. "The captain had to put them all over the ship."
