Viet Vets Protest At White House

About 15 American combat veterans of Vietnam were joined by former Maj. Gen. Edwin A. Walker in front of the White House yesterday for a protest against the U.S. abandonment of the South Vietnamese government in Saigon.

Led by two young ex-soldiers carrying the American and Vietnamese flags, some of the demonstrators marched in a wide oval on the sidewalk and chanted, "Hey, hey, Henry Kissinger! You made the Communists a whole lot richer!" The group said it also wanted to learn the fate of prisoners of war and those missing in action in Indochina.

Their principal spokesman, Dean Allen, a former Army sergeant and industrial worker from Texas City, Tex., said the group has formed Vets for Victory over Communism and is prepared to go back overseas to fight communist aggression.
