Bitter Toward U.S.

OTTAWA—The charge d'affaires of the former South Vietnamese embassy here said he will seek immigrant status in Canada and that he "would never go to the United States."

Explaining that he had lived in the United States for four and half years, the charge, Nguyen Quoc Tan, said:

"I have been watching what the Americans did to Vietnam, how they treated us . . . That would be a terrible situation for me if I had to live among Americans again."

Asked if he was bitter, he replied: "That's the least I could say." He added that he could not go back to Saigon "because my life would be in danger."
