France Offering to Accept Refugees From Indochina

PARIS, May 8 — France has offered to receive Indochinese refugees "who are to some degree assimilable, without any quota," a government spokesman said today.

President Valéry Giscard d'Estaing announced willingness to admit refugees who are "attached to French culture." After yesterday's cabinet meeting.

Government spokesmen said that no details had been worked out yet but that French consulates would soon be giving instructions on handling requests for visas. The offer applies not only to metropolitan France, they said, but also to French territories overseas.
