Charges yesterday and herd on \$5,000 bail. "I trusted him because I knew his wife," said Nguyen Thi Cahn, 21 years old. She and her sister Nguyen Thi Hue, 13, and son, Nguyen Nhut Huu, 3, traveled from Vietnam to Camp Pendleton with Mr. Lawson. He had been their neighbor in Saigon and signed sponsorship papers to escort the family to the United States with him and his Vietnamese wife, the police said.
