

## Thai Demonstrators Seek

### Expulsion of Vietnamese

BANGKOK, Thailand, May 11 (Reuters)—About 2,000 people demonstrated in the town of Sakonnakhon in northeast Thailand today demanding the expulsion of all Vietnamese from the country.

The police said shops owned by Vietnamese were attacked and at least one person was injured in clashes between demonstrators and members of the 5,000-strong Vietnamese community in Sakonnakhon, 400 miles northeast of Bangkok.

The governor of Sakonnakhon, Sorn Sutthisarn, said he could not speculate on the causes of the flare-up until an investigation was completed.

About 70,000 refugees from what is now North Vietnam settled in Thailand after Vietnam was divided at the end of the French Indochina war in 1954.
