

## Martin Returns to Manila

### After Resting in Mountains

MANILA, May 12 (AP)—Graham Martin, the last American ambassador in Saigon, has come to Manila from Baguio, the mountain resort 120 miles north of Manila, after a week's rest there, the United States Embassy announced today. But a spokesman refused to say where Mr. Martin was going next or when he would be leaving.

An embassy spokesman also said Mr. Martin would not comment on reports that his staff in Saigon left behind hundreds of Vietnamese employed by the United States Government and that a number of American evacuees were "openly bitter about Ambassador Martin's failure to make firm, clear decisions on how the evacuation plan would actually be carried out."

Mr. Martin, who left Saigon on one of the last evacuation flights, stayed at the United State Ambassador's official residence at Camp John Hay, a United States military resort camp in Baguio.

"Ambassador Martin said he is not ready to announce his plans," the embassy spokesman said.
