Saigon Cable

Circuit Reopened HONG KONG, May 16(AP)—Direct commercial cable traffic between Hong Kong and Saigon was restored today.

Cable and Wireless, the international communications company, said the new South Vietnamese government informed it that the circuit for all classes of cables was reopened at 11(36 a.m. (10:36 p.m. E.D.T. Thursday).

Service on the circuit was suspended April 30 when Communist forces captured Saigon. Since then, cables from Hong Kong to Saigon have been routed through Hanoi, and the traffic was restricted by the North Vietnamese.
