About 400 Vietnamese refugees are expected to begin arriving tomorrow at the Weimar Medical Center here in the Sierra foothills, a spokesman at the center said yesterday.

The refugees originally had been expected to be transferred from Camp Pendleton in Southern California earlier in the week. But some minor repairs had to be made to the old tuberculey of the sponsoring organization, Food the Hungry.
