## SAIGON DEMANDS U.S. RETURN MUSEUM ART

SINGAPORE, May 26 (Reuters)—The South Vietnamese administration today demanded that the United States return art treasures reported shipped out of the country to Guam, the Saigon radio said.

The radio, monitored here, said the Foreign Ministry strongly protested against what it called the United States confiscation of the treasures from the National Museum of Saigon.

Officials in Guam said on Friday that Vietnamese art treasures and diplomatic archives had been shipped to Guam aboard a refugee boat a week earlier.

United States military, State Department and Guam government officials refused to disclose details of the contents of two large wooden crates that arrived with the refugees but they did say they included valuable works of art.
