

AMERICAN RESIDENT ARRESTED IN LAOS

VIENTIANE, Laos, June 9 (UPI)—United States Embassy officials said today that a long-time American resident of Laos was arrested last week and was being held by authorities on charges of plotting against the Government of Premier Souvanna Phouma.

The woman, identified as Rosemary Conway, was charged in a reported plot to fly T-28 fighter-bombers out of Laos, according to Laotian sources. The American embassy said it was unable to confirm the charge.

The embassy said that Miss Conway—her age and American address were not known—had no connection with the official United States operation in Laos.
