

**Cambodia Reds' Policy
Denounced by Lon Nol**

HONOLULU, July 1 (UPI)
—Former President Lon Nol of Cambodia says the new Communist authorities have violated the agreement under which he voluntarily left his homeland.

In a lengthy declaration written in French, he called on the nations of the world to intervene in Cambodia to halt alleged atrocities.

Marshal Lon Nol said the Communists had deported two million people from Phnom Penh.

"It is further reported that there is famine and epidemics—it is imperative to ask institutions and world organizations to intervene," the exiled president said.
