

Canada Is Ousting Vietnamese General

Canada announced yesterday it has ordered the deportation of a refugee South Vietnamese general on grounds of "nefarious activities" in his homeland.

Manpower and Immigration Minister Robert Andras said General Dang Van Quang could elect to leave Canada voluntarily before the deportation order is executed. No date was set for his departure.

Deportation would be either to the United States, Quang's most recent stop-over point, or South Vietnam, Andras said.

The minister said investigations conducted by his department showed Quang "has been guilty of nefarious activities both in the drug trade and other corrup-

tion practices, but I can not go much further than that."
