Saigon General Files Appeal
Against Ottawa Ouster Move

MONTREAL, July 15 (Reuters)—Lieut. Gen. Dang Van Quang, an official in the former South Vietnamese Government, has petitioned to have a deportation order quashed by the Canadian Immigration Appeal Board.

The petition, claiming refugee status, was filed yesterday. The order was issued by Immi-

gration Minister Robert Andras. The general, who came to Canada on a special ministerial permit and applied for landed immigrant status, was national security adviser to President Nguyen Van Thieu before the Communist victory.
