Two Saigon Observers To the U.N. Fly Here

The first two officials of South Vietnam's new Communist Government to come to the United States arrived at Kennedy Airport yesterday and were welcomed by Communist diplomats, antiwar activists and two former prisoners of war.

They are Dinh Ba Thi and Huynh Huu Nghiep, who will be observers for South Vietnam at the United Nations.

At a reception in the Church of the United Nations, Mr. Thi, in answer to questions, said: "We would like to establish diplomatic relations with the United States. Now it is up to the United States Government."
