WXPost AUG 8 1975 -U.S. Seen Unwilling To Fight in Asia Beuter

TOKYO, Aug. 7—The United States will not become involved in another land war in Asia because the people will not support it, despite talk of Japan and Korea being different from Indochina, a retired U.S. naval officer said here today.

Rear Adm. Gene La Roque said the nuclear deterrent may work for the United States but not for other countries. He added: "We are not going to strike Moscow to save Tokyo and lose Washhington in the deal." Adm. La Roque is director of the Center for Defense Information in Washington.
