

U.S. Won't Readmit Viet General

Washington

The United States has refused to readmit South Vietnamese Lieutenant General Dang Van Quang, the State Department said yesterday.

Quang first arrived in the United States May 15 with the first flood of South Vietnamese refugees. Later, however, as fellow refugees spread stories of his alleged brutality and trafficking in heroin, he migrated to Canada.

The Canadian government later ordered him deported for "nefarious activities in the drug trade" and other crimes while serving as a principal aide to former President Nguyen Van Thieu.
