## MIA Response

### Held Possible

MOSCOW, Aug. 18 (UPI)—  
Premier Alexei Kosygin told  
visiting U.S. presidential can-  
didate Terry Sanford today  
that he feels the Vietnamese  
would be responsible to a  
“proper approach” by the  
United States about men miss-  
ing in action in Indochina.

Sanford, former governor  
of North Carolina and an an-  
nounced candidate for the  
Democratic presidential nomi-  
nation in 1976, said Kosygin  
hinted that there might be  
some counterdemand on the  
part of the Vietnamese if they  
permitted American search  
teams to visit North Vietnam  
to search for the bodies of  
missing men.

One possible concession  
cited by Kosygin as an illus-  
tration might be American ap-  
proval of Vietnamese member-  
ship in the United Nations,  
Sanford said. The United  
States vetoed membership for  
North and South Vietnam  
when the U.N. Security Coun-  
cil voted on the issue Aug. 11.
