### Refugees Moved

MARION, N.C.—The Vietnamese Buddhist refugees placed in a fundamentalist Christian religious camp near here have been transferred to a Houston relocation center after they asked county officials for help in leaving the camp.

The McDowell County department of social services said the refugees and one other who is hospitalized for tuberculosis, were unhappy in the compounds of The Way, The Truth and The Life, but were afraid to express their feelings to the camp operator.

Four refugees contacted the Red Cross in Asheville, N.C., and said they would run away if they were not moved by the International Rescue Committee that placed them there.
