

## **Cambodian Says Nation Is One Vast Workshop**

LIMA, Peru, Aug. 28 (Reuters)—Deputy Premier Ieng Sary of Cambodia told the nonaligned nations conference here today that his country was one great workshop, with people struggling to restore industry, agriculture and communications destroyed in the Indochina war.

The first Cambodian representative to attend an international assembly since the end of the war, Mr. Ieng Sary criticized the United States for what he termed its campaign of calumny.

He said that American troops should be withdrawn from South Korea and that the United States should stop backing in for separate membership of the United Nations and permit the entry of North and South Vietnam. He also urged Korean reunification.

Asked by reporters if he would go to New York next week for the special session of the United Nations General Assembly, he replied affirmatively. Cambodia has had no delegation at the United Nations since the overthrow of the Government of Marshal Lon Nol in April.
