Mail Service Halted

To South Vietnam

Mail service to South Vietnam has been suspended, the U.S. Postal Service announced yesterday after being advised by the Soviet Union that South Vietnam refuses to accept mail from the United States.

All mail for South Vietnam will be returned to the sender, marked "service temporarily suspended," it said, and customers will be able to receive a refund on postage at any post office.

The Postal Service said it is continuing efforts to arrange a resumption of service with Saigon.
