Prince's Travels

Cambodian Prince Norodom Sihanouk left Peking for Hanoi to attend North Vietnam's 30th anniversary of independence. The Japanese Kyodo news service reported from Peking that Sihanouk will return there before leaving for Cambodia around Sept. 10. It will be his first home visit in five years.

In Bangkok, U.S. officials said that three former top Laotian officers and their 35 dependents have been granted asylum in the United States in response to Thai calls for the refugees to leave. But thousands of other Laotian refugees appeared to face repatriation.
