Nguyen Cao Ky as 'Jobless Refugee'

In your newspaper September 18, I read that my former playboy Premier and vice president Nguyen Cao Ky, gave a lecture to students at the University of Virginia. In the lecture, Ky claimed that he is now "a jobless refugee" in the United States. It's very funny. I don't know why he claimed that he is unemployed, since he makes \$2,500 for each 30-minute lecture, and he is going to make 49 more lectures in the coming days in the nation's colleges.

We can count how much he will make in the near future. Compare this

with the salaries of other refugees. I have met with some former high-ranking officers and officials in the former Saigon government, and they are making from \$250 to \$300 per month here. Many of them have accepted jobs as waiters, clerks and so forth—such as former South Vietnamese three-star General Dong Van Khuyen, who works for a restaurant as a waiter.

Meanwhile, many other Vietnamese refugees cannot find a job. Did Ky help them?
