Resettling of Indo Refugees Reported Almost Finished

Washington

The resettling of Indochina refugees should be completed by mid-December, the head of the resettlement program told Congress yesterday.

Julia Vadala Taft, director of the Interagency Task Force for Indochina, said 29,000 refugees remain to be resettled of the 137,000 who entered the system.

Testifying before the House immigration subcommittee, Mrs. Taft said plans call for closing the Camp Pendleton refugee camp by November 1.
