Vietnam to Let 50 **U.S. Civilians Leave**

Hanoi and the new government of South Vietnam have agreed to let 50 to 60 American civilians leave South Vietname late this month or early in November, Representative G. V. Montgomery said yesterday.

The Americans include missionaries and U.S. State Department employees who did not leave with the U.S. evacuation of Saigon just before it fell, the Mississippi Democrat said.

Montgomery made the announcement to the House as chairman of its new Select Committee for Missing Persons in Southeast Asia.
