Nguyen Cao Ky, the former Vice President of South Vietnam, has been urging the return of some United States troops to South Vietnam to protect refugees who want to return home. In one of his numerous lectures, given Wednesday night at the University of Florida at Gainesville, there was heckling and protest signs, including one that read, "Out of South Vietnam Forever." But when the former Vice President asked for questions, the first one involved an allegation that he was involved in heroin sales in South Vietnam. Mr. Ky was so upset that he left the platform, to a chorus of boos from the 900-student audience and under heavy police guard.
