Thailand and Cambodia have established diplomatic relations following the visit to Bangkok of an eight-man Cambodian government delegation led by Deputy Premier Ieng Sary.

The delegation, which included Justice Minister Norodon Purisara, a cousin of Prince Norodom Shihanouk, the nominal head of state, and the Cambodian ambassadors to China and Senegal, returned to Phnom Penh Saturday in a Boeing 707, put at their disposal by the Chinese government.
