**ALL VIETNAM TO USE
HANOI VOTING SET-UP**

SAIGON, South Vietnam, Nov. 18 (Agence France-Presse) —The electoral system in South Vietnam will be set up like North Vietnam's for the election of a constituent assembly for the whole of Vietnam.

This has been decided by the conference on the reunification of Vietnam, which opened here Saturday.

The proposal to follow the electoral example of North Vietnam was made at the opening session by Truong Chinh, speaker of the North Vietnamese National Assembly.

He also announced the merger of North Vietnam's Patriotic Front and South Vietnam's National Liberation Front.

Representatives of the two groups have always appeared together in public ceremonies since the capture of Saigon.

The reunification conference decided to make the minimum voting age 18. Candidates must be at least 21.

Mr. Truong Chinh's inaugural report was approved without reservations by Pham Hung, head of the South Vietnamese delegation.
