

226 Ineligible Vietnam 'Orphans' — So Far

Of the 1850 Vietnamese children brought to the United States in the "orphan airlift" earlier this year, 226 have been found ineligible for adoption, and the number may grow to 275.

The Immigration and Naturalization Service findings were relayed by Assistant U.S. Attorney John J. Cooney Jr. to U.S. District Judge Spencer Williams yesterday, in the course of

hearings on the children's legal status.

About 1600 of the cases have so far been investigated.
