The last Yanks in North Viet

PARIS—North Vietnamese Ambassador Vo Van Sung announced today that the bodies of three American pilots killed in the Vietnam War would be turned over to their families in the next few days.

But he said his government was holding no other Americans, dead or alive, and added that there was no trace of some 850 Americans listed as missing in action or still held prisoner.

The three pilots were Maj. Jesse Taylor Jr., Long Beach, shot down Jan. 16, 1965; Maj. Crosley James Fitton, Universal City, Tex., downed Feb. 29, 1968, and Capt. Ronald Dwight Perry, Gallatia, Tex., killed Dec. 21, 1972
