Cambodia announced yesterday it has changed its name to "Democratic Cambodia" and has formed a new government with a new constitution.

In a broadcast monitored in Bangkok, the official radio station in Phnom Penh announced the name change and said the new government will be "neutral and unaligned."

The broadcast said Prince Norodom Sihanouk will remain chief of state under a constituion that took effect yesterday. Details of the constitution, approved by a council of government ministers Saturday, will be announced later, the broadcast said.

The drafting of the constitu-
