The government announced yesterday a \$109,000 program to help Indochina refugees continue their college education in this country.

The Department of Health, Education and Welfare said the money would go to California State University at Long Beach to pay for evaluating transcripts from Vietnam and Cambodia. The records will be converted into American education equivalencies, enabling the refugees to continue their educations in U.S. colleges and universities
