Ottawa Asks South Vietnam If It Will Accept Ex-General

Victorian if it will accept the remunist Government of South Vietnam if it will accept the return of former Gen. Dang Van Quang, according to Immigration Minister Robert Andras.

An aide to Mr. Andras said the Saigon Government had been asked to state how it would deal with Mr. Quang if he should be returned. When a reply is received, he said, Canada will decide whether to send him back.

Mr. Quang, accused by other Vietnamese refugees of corruption and trafficking in drugs, was ordered deported last July, but Canada has not found a country that would accept him. The former general originally arrived in the United States, and entered Canada last May from a United States refugee camp with a ministerial permit that was revoked by Mr. Andres last July.
