

## 29 Americans and Families Are to Leave Saigon Sunday

BANGKOK, Thailand, July 26 (AP)—Twenty-nine Americans and 12 Vietnamese dependents are to be flown here from Saigon Sunday, a United Nations spokesman said today.

Arrangements are also being made to evacuate 80 Filipinos from the former South Vietnamese capital, but the spokesman of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees said their departure date was not fixed.

A group of Americans and their dependents were about to board a flight from Saigon July 9 when they were stopped on a technicality.

Some of the Americans and Filipinos stayed behind voluntarily after the Communist victory in Vietnam in April 1975. Others were unable to get out during the chaotic American evacuation.
