Oust Nixon Resolution By ADA

WASHINGTON — (UPI) — The Americans for Democratic Action said last night President Nixon's Cambodia decision is "just cause for impeachment proceedings."

The resolution was approved by voice vote at the 23rd annual convention of the ADA, which has opposed for several years U.S. involvement in Vietnam. It compared the move into Cambodia with the Russian invasion of Czechoslovakia.

The resolution said the Administration has caused "a grave constitutional crisis by an illegal act of war."

The vote came after an hour of debate over the language of the sentence involving impeachment.

As originally drafted by the convention's foreign policy commission, the resolution said:

"But for the awesome threat of the succession of Spiro Agnew, ADA would consider this just cause for the initiation of impeachment proceedings in the House of Representatives against the President."

By a standing vote of 98 to 49, the delegates deleted that language. Then they voted 110 to 55 to say the ADA "considers this just cause for the initiation of impeachment proceedings in the House of Representatives against the President."
