

WHO WILL SPEAK OUT FOR OUR MEN IN VIETNAM?

The stepped-up communist invasion of Cambodia directly imperils the lives of America's fighting men in Vietnam.

The President has acted decisively to protect those men by cleaning out communist sanctuaries, some of which are only 33 miles from Saigon.

This will make possible the orderly withdrawal of 150,000 Americans during the next year, without endangering the lives of those remaining.

The President spoke for all Americans. "I promised to end the war. I shall keep that promise. I promised to win a just peace. I shall keep that promise. We shall avoid a wider war. But we are also determined to put an end to this war."
