Anti-Nixon Mail Flood

Senator Alan Cranston (Dem-Calif.) said yesterday his mail is running three times the usual volume, most of it opposing president Nixon's policy in Cambodia.

Cranston said he has been receiving 3000 letters a day the past 11 days. Of the nearly 23,000 pieces of mail concerning the Southeast Asia question, more than 21,000 were against Mr. Nixon's stand, Cranston said.
