

Yorty's Hard Hat Party

Mayor Sam Yorty said yesterday that the construction workers such as those who marched in New York in support of President Nixon represent "the party I want to be a part of."

Campaigning in San Diego county for the Democratic gubernatorial nomination, Yorty said the once-canceled and since rescheduled UCLA naval ROTC parade should be held in the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum with blue collar workers as spectators.

He defended the President's dispatch of American troops into Cambodia. He accused Assemblyman Jess Unruh, his opponent in next week's primary, of being "purely opportunistic" in placing petitions in his various campaign headquarters backing a Senate amendment to withhold funds for troop use in Cambodia.
