

## **Fulbright Describes Ky As 'an Asian Agnew'**

WASHINGTON, May 28 (AP)—Senator J. W. Fulbright, describing Vice President Nguyen Cao Ky of South Vietnam as “an Asian Agnew,” charged today that Saigon’s leaders were determined “to keep the Americans mired in the swamp” of Cambodia.

Mr. Fulbright, Democrat of Arkansas, also contended that the Nixon Administration “apparently intends to sustain an indefinite, full-scale military involvement by proxy in Cambodia.”

The Senate agreed, meanwhile, to vote next Wednesday on an amendment expected to provide the first real test of strength in the debate on United States involvement in Cambodia.

The amendment of Senator Robert J. Dole, Republican of Kansas, would bar enforcement of the pending proposal to cut off funds for “retaining” United States troops in Cambodia until the Communists release all American prisoners in that country.
