KENT STATE FATHER SUES FOR \$6-MILLION

CLEVELAND, June 11 (UPI)

Gov. James A. Rhodes and two National Guard officials are charged with "intentionally and maliciously" disregarding lives in a \$6-million wrongful death suit filed yesterday by the father of one of four Kent State students killed by Guard bullets.

The suit was filed in Federal Court on behalf of Arthur Krause of Pittsburgh, whose daughter, Allison, 19 years old, was killed May 4 when National Guardsmen fired on a group of demonstrators at Kent State.

Named as defendants were Governor Rhodes; Adj. Gen. Sylvester Del Corso, commander of the Ohio National

Guard, and Brig. Gen. Robert H. Canterbury, in charge of the troops sent to Kent State.

Steven A. Sindell, lawyer, filed the suit for Mr. Krause. It said that the defendants had "intentionally and maliciously disregarded the lives and safety of students, spectators and passersby, including Allison Krause."
